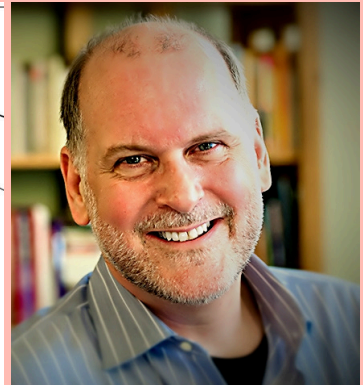
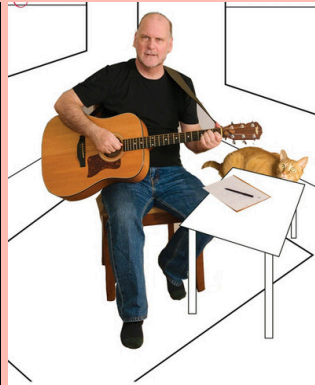

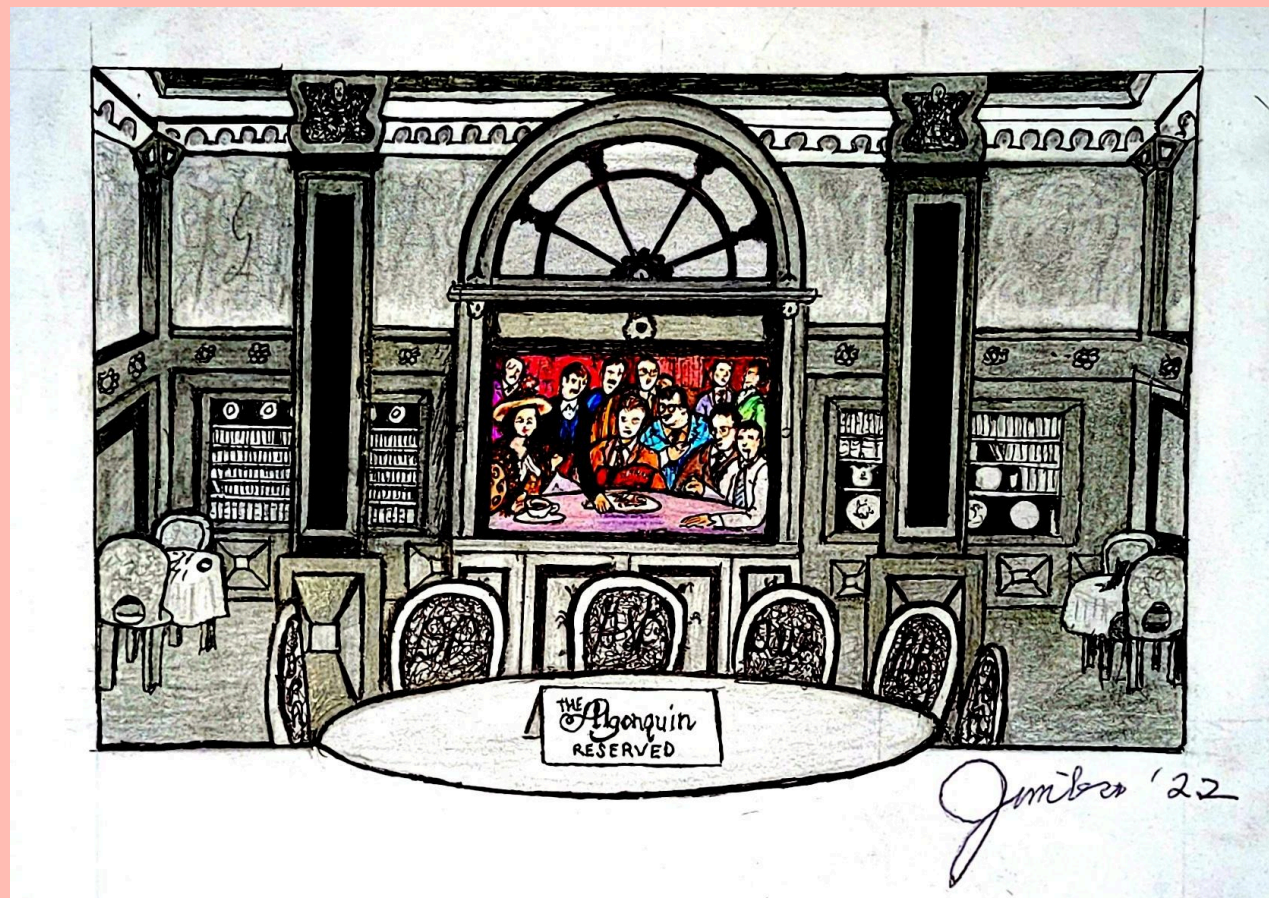
a "Permanent Collection" of customizable tableware and an always-changing selection of "One of a kind" sculptural vessels and objects.
